The moment a survivor decides to leave their trafficker. The moment they land their job. The moment they get the keys to their new home. The moment a family is reunited.

These are just some of the moments freedom becomes real.

The Venue

The 2023 Freedom Gala will be held at the TriBeCa Rooftop. This chic industrial venue is located in the trendy downtown neighborhood of Tribeca, New York City. Located on a cobblestone street in a 1920's printing press building, the venue boasts incredible rooftop views of New York City's iconic scenery.



Thousands of women are sold for sex every day in NYC, in every neighborhood of every borough. An estimated 50,000,000 people worldwide and 10,000 people in NYC are being trafficked right now.

Human trafficking is a \$150 billion global industry and the second largest illegal activity, only to drug trafficking.

Despite the enormous scale of the problem of human trafficking, only 2% of philanthropic funding in the U.S. goes to women's causes, with much less specifically supporting anti-trafficking initiatives.

Alongside partners like you, Restore is working to end trafficking and to make freedom real for survivors. We empower each survivor to thrive in her community and ultimately experience sustained freedom—and we have the data to prove it.

Restore NYC is a nonprofit organization making freedom real for survivors of trafficking in the United States.

About Restore NYC

Restore NYC serves over 450 people every year and over 270 people in our long-term core services. Restore has over 11,000 supportive interactions with survivors in a given year and serves survivors on average of 2 years with trauma-informed services. One of only two transitional homes and the only low-barrier transitional housing option in NYC for survivors.

When survivors first join Restore, 32% are homeless or incarcerated, 69% are unemployed or in unsafe work, 60% do not have a high school diploma, and 57% have no work authorization as they wait for their trafficking visa. Yet, their strengths and resiliency are what drives Restore's mission forward.

We serve survivors of trafficking through three core programs:



Client Services

Clinical counseling, comprehensive case management, and resource coordination



Housing

Emergency housing, transitional housing, and independent living



Economic Empowerment

Job-readiness classes, job placement, and entrepreneurship training and incubation
